



**Request for Expression of Interest**  
**Senior National Infrastructure Engineering Consultant (Ref. No. MLMUPC-CS-32)**

**Project Background**

The PDO is to provide access to land tenure security, agricultural and social services, and selected infrastructure to small farmers and communities in Indigenous Communal Land Titling (ICLT) and Social Land Concession (SLC) project areas as well as prepare Commune Land Use Planning (CLUP) in Cambodia. Ministry of Land Management Urban Planning and Construction (MLMUPC) as Executive Agency and Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) as Implementing Agency have received financing from the World Bank for Land Allocation for Social and Economic Development Project III (LASED III). LASED III will support activities involving small scale irrigation distribution networks from already existing wells or intakes at 7 existing LASED II SLCs and provide support to 12 new SLCs, 33 ICLTs that have received communal land titles and 15 IP communities that have applied for ICLT and prepare CLUP for 450 communes.

**Main Duties and Responsibilities**

- Cooperate with project officers to design tools and strategies for CID activities in accordance with the project design in the PAD, ESMF, PIM, and IPPF;
- Monitor the project progress and produce monthly reports for Project Operations Section Director based on the defined monitoring and reporting format;
- Collect and analyze necessary information to support the project implementation including specific environmental and social assessments and land surveys of Indigenous Communal Land Titling (ICLT) and Social Land Concession (SLC) sites related to infrastructure need assessment, detailed designs and implementation of infrastructure development activities;
- Supervise the organizational set-up, operation, and reporting related to the project's studies, detailed engineering design and implementation of CID;
- Provides technical support and prepares all civil works packages (including the technical designs) for submission to project director and project management team for review and to the World Bank for "No-Objection";
- Provide the technical support to the procurement process, and
- Others relative tasks requested by Project Directors.

**Required Skills and Qualifications**

- At least a Master's degree (or higher is plus) in civil engineering field; with specification in road engineering is preferable.
- At least 15 years working experience in infrastructure design, construction and supervision as well as project management experience; awareness and experience with ICLT and SLC would be an advantage. Experience in road and/or irrigation engineering is preferable.
- using computing tools for survey, technical analysis, technical design and project management (e.g. etc.) Previous and relevant experience, at least 10 years working with project related to Rural Infrastructure Implementation with the World Bank and/or other International Agencies projects;
- High level computer skills in structural analysis, infrastructure survey and design, CAD, GIS and thorough understanding of database design and management (highly desirable);
- Excellent Khmer language verbal and written communication and very good verbal and written communication in English; and
- Ability and willingness to travel regularly to the provinces.

The individual consultants will be based in LASED III, MLMUPC, Phnom Penh and traveled project areas.

The selection process will be carried out in accordance with provisions set forth in the Government Procurement Manual for Externally Financed Projects/Programs in Cambodia and Approved Selection Method for Individual Consultants - Section VII. Approved Selection Methods: Consulting Services of the World Bank Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, dated July 2016, revised November 2017 and August 2018.
